Gifts with Vision

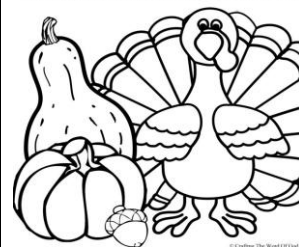
